Major Project

One of the main mottos of Inner Wheel is to touch people's lives. In Bayview we take this responsibility very seriously and attempt to do so for underprivileged people. Fortunately, we have made a significant impact in a short span of eight years. Below is a glimpse of our projects: We started food distribution for the cancer patients and their families near Tata Hospital in our inception year and this remains one of our flagship projects.


Our second flagship project is Indradhanush - a drawing and painting competition for the children of different NGO's on Republic Day.

Educational - We have made many "Happy Schools and Much More" by making toilet blocks, renovating classrooms and a library, providing playground equipment, making science labs, installing e-learning, opening computer labs, distributing necessary items like shoes, socks, sweaters, school bags, educational and entertaining books and raincoats. We also did an international project by renovating a school building in Sri Lanka.

Medical & Health - We have donated an Ambulance at Talasari hospital-Dahanu, Emergency vehicle at Sangopita, many equipment in Tata Hospital and Wadia Hospital, multiple Anemia camps, Medical camps, Blood Donation camps, Cancer checkup camps, Organ Donation awareness camps organized at different places. We celebrated Diwali and other festivals with cancer patients and gave gifts on several these occasions. We have also given a water filter, water tanks at different NGO's and hospitals and donated 3 fully furnished units to children suffering from cancer.

Vocational- We have donated Computers for the Vocational courses at different places. Many girls are taught computers by one of our members. We have made tailoring units at Dahanu, Dev Krupa Mandal etc.

Environment- We have done organic farming and always supported Inner wheel Forest. We have donated solar lights and spread the awareness about solar energy. We have made a few wells and executed a rainwater harvesting project.

Women Empowerment- We conducted defence training classes for girls in many schools and worked out a micro-credit scheme for women.

Miscellaneous- Lift for an Old Age home, prosthetic hands for a handicap boy, 25 toilet blocks for Wakdi, construction of a garden in South Bombay, picnic for the senior citizens, special children, cancer patients etc.
